To be considered, Fast50 nominees must have been in business for at least three years, generate more than \$750,000 of revenue, employ five or more people, be independent and privately owned (not publicly traded or a subsidiary) and be headquartered in Tennessee. KraftCPAs reviewed the submitted nominations.

Business Tennessee is a statewide monthly magazine covering business and politics and is received by 42,000 business and civic leaders in Tennessee.
